

YARD WASTE - Yard waste pickup begins the first Monday in March and every Monday until October. Please properly bag your leaves in recyclable paper bags. Limbs need to be tied together in small bunches. American Disposal will not take household trash if there is any amount of yard waste mixed in.

OPEN SPACES IN TOWNHOMES – Some open parking spaces in the townhomes may be changed over to visitor parking spaces this summer, requiring a visitor parking permit. This change is due to the number of residents that are using visitor spaces for a resident of the home and not visitors. This will be the first step to alleviate non- visitors from using a visitor space. The next step may be to limit the number of nights during the week any vehicle can park in a visitor space and it will be monitored by the towing company.

INSPECTIONS — It's that time of year. We will be inspecting every home in the community starting mid-April. This process takes several months to complete. As the weather changes it is the perfect time to look around your home to see what work needs to be done such as power washing your siding or fencing, repairs to mailboxes in the single family homes, fence cleaning and repairs, etc.

SEE YOU AT THE POOL – The 2025 pool season begins Saturday May 24th. Pool opens at 10:00 A.M. A copy of the rules and regulations will be available at the pool. Please register on Cell Badge prior to opening day. We welcome back Millennium Pools. If you need help registering please give us a call or feel free to stop in the office.

PAYMENTS – Please do not drop payments off at Cardinal Management in Woodbridge. There could be a delay in having your payment processed. We encourage everyone to have direct debit from your checking account known as ACH. There is also property pay. You can go to cardinalmanagementgroup.com for information on paying. If you use your coupons please mail them no later than the first of the month. If you use your bank to send checks please make sure they are mailing them in a timely fashion. Many payments from banks are not getting in until after the 10th of the month. Late fees will not be credited for late payments.

FRONT LIGHT POST — Please take note of the policy resolution in this newsletter concerning having lights on in front of your home. All lights on your home and light post are required to be on. This helps in lighting up the streets and the neighborhood.

PROPERTY PAY - Just a friendly reminder the Property Pay is a third party vendor. Management does not have access to any of your information you use to pay. If using property pay please make your payment before the 10th so it shows up by the 10th.



YARD WASTE GOES OUT EVERY MONDAY. LEAVES MUST BE IN BROWN RECYLABLE BAGS ONLY, THEY WILL NOT BE TAKEN IF IN PLASTIC. STICKS AND BRANCHES NEED TO BE TIED TOGETHER IN SMALL BUNCHES. GRASS CLIPPINGS GO IN RECYCLABLE BAGS AS WELL. HOUSEHOLD TRASH WILL NOT BE TAKEN IF THERE IS ANY AMOUNT OF YARD WASTE MIXED IN.



WHY ARE YOU INSPECTING MY HOUSE?

Inspections of every home is performed beginning in April of each year. This is our normal yearly inspections that last all summer. Owners with violations will receive a "Friendly Reminder" prior to a formal violation unless the violation is of a serious nature. We also randomly inspect when we are out and about in the fall and winter. We are also required to do an inspection of every home being sold as part of the resale packet. For any violation we must follow due process as required by the State which requires a hearing before the Covenants Committee and/or Board of Directors with fines being imposed if violations are not cured.



EVERYONE IS ENCOURAGED TO KEEP THEIR TRASH CANS BEHIND THEIR FENCES AND BACK YARDS ON NON TRASH DAYS, HOWEVER WE REALIZE FOR SOME BRINING THEIR TRASH CANS AROUND TO THE FRONT IS NEARLY IMPOSSIBLE WHICH IS WHY SO MANY PLACE TRASH BAGS ON THE GROUND WHICH INVITES RODENTS, RACOONS AND SKUNKS. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO KEEP YOUR TRASH CANS ON THE SIDE OF YOUR HOUSE OR IN FRONT, OUT OF THE WAY, YOU CAN DO SO BUY PLACING A FENCE AROUND THEM AS PICTURED ABOVE. WHITE ONLY. THIS WILL HELP KEEP TRASH OFF THE GROUND AND WILL HIDE THE TRASH CANS.



SOUTHBRIDGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION POLICY RESOLUTION NO 02-2010-1

(Relation to Maintenance of Exterior Lights on the Lots)

WHEREAS, Article 4, Section 4.1 of the Bylaws provides that the Board of Directors shall have all of the powers and duties necessary for the administration of the affairs of the Association, including the power, among other things, to adopt, amend and enforce Rules and Regulation not inconsistent with the Association; and

WHEREAS, Article 7, Section 7.2 of the Declaration states, in part that, "Each Owner shall keep such Owner's Lot and all improvements located on the Lot in good order, condition and repair...," and,

WHEREAS, each Lot has exterior lighting as an improvement on the Lot; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors believes it is in the best interest of the Association to establish a rule with respect to the maintenance of the exterior lights of the lots.

NOW, THEREFORE, the following Rule is hereby established governing the maintenance of exterior lights on the Lots, which supersedes and replaces any previously-adopted rules or policies relating to the same subject.

I. Policy:

- a. Exterior lights must be turned on from dusk until dawn each night.
- b. Replacement.
 - 1. If the exterior light is repaired or replaced, such light must be equipped with a photocell light sensor.
- ii. If the exterior light is repaired pr replaced, such light must be maintained. If necessary, non-working photocell light sensors must be repaired or replaced.

II. Enforcement:

- a. Failure to maintain the exterior lights in accordance with this Rule constitutes a violation of the Association Documents.
- b. The Association reserves all its rights and remedies to enforce the provisions of its Association Documents, including but not limited to, the imposition of monetary charges and the suspension of the membership privileges, following all requisite due process procedures.

ANYONE LIVING IN THE TOWNHOMES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO USE A VISITOR HANG TAG.
BECAUSE SO MANY RESIDENTS ARE USING THE VISITOR SPOTS WE ARE WORKING ON NEW
RULES WHICH MAY INCLUDE MONITORING THE SPOTS NIGHTLY AND TOWING ANY VEHICLE
THAT IS PARKED IN A VISITOR SPACE MORE THAN 3 NIGHTS DURING THE WEEK WHICH WILL
BE THE LIMIT. TOO MANY COMPLAINTS ARE COMING IN ABOUT RESIDENTS USING THE
VISITOR SPACES AND THOSE WHO HAVE VISITORS CANNOT FIND A SPOT. AS A REMINDER
EACH TOWNHOME ONLY GETS TWO RESIDENT PARKING SPACES.


